The SIT20316 Certificate II in Hospitality provides students with the opportunity to learn a range of basic yet important hospitality operational skills. These practical skills are combined with solid industry knowledge and are directly transferrable to the smooth running of everyday tasks in a supervised hospitality environment.

Students successfully completing this course may enter further Business or management qualifications at CTI or progress to a wide range of other qualifications in the Hospitality and broader service industries.

The course will take 26 weeks to complete with 2.5 days of contact per week encompassing a range of core skills from administration elements to customer service, communication and work safety elements. Each graduate will have a competent understanding of all aspects involved in a supervised hospitality environment.
