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Entry Requirements:

- An overall IELTS band 5.5 or equivalent and above;
- 18 years and above with a High School Certificate (Year 12)
- A verified copy of qualification & transcripts is required along with the application
- Qualification & transcripts needs to be verified by CTI's approved student recruitment agent to confirm their genuine status

Preferred Pathways:

Candidates may enter the qualification through a number of entry points demonstrating potential to undertake vocational education and training at advanced diploma level, including after achieving BSB51915 Diploma of Leadership and Management or other relevant qualification/s. Completion of the Diploma level qualification prior to entry is recommended. Students may be able to gain credits for units completed from the CTI BSB60215 Advanced Diploma of Business where applicable.

Course Pathway:

Following the completion of the BSB51915 Diploma of Leadership and Management, students are able to progress into; Diploma of Business, Advanced Diploma of Business, Diploma of Software Development, or Diploma of Digital and Interactive Games at Canterbury Technical Institute. Students also have the opportunity to further their studies and continue onto university study.
