


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Advanced Diploma of Leadership & Management BSB61015







The BSB61015 Advanced Diploma of Leadership and Management has been designed to reflect the role of individuals who have senior or managerial responsibilities. They may oversee the work of others or have specialised roles where they do not supervise others, instead provide strategic leadership. Students will learn the importance of providing leadership across an organisation while gaining the skill and knowledge to develop and implement strategic plans.

This course is suited for candidates wishing to pursue careers in roles such as area managers, department managers and regional managers.

Entry Requirements:

- An overall IELTS band 5.5 or equivalent and above;
- 18 years and above with a High School Certificate (Year 12)
- A verified copy of qualification & transcripts is required along with the application
- Qualification & transcripts needs to be verified by CTI's approved student recruitment agent to confirm their genuine status

Preferred Pathways:

Candidates may enter the qualification through a number of entry points demonstrating potential to undertake vocational education and training at advanced diploma level, including after achieving BSB51915 Diploma of Leadership and Management or other relevant qualification/s. Completion of the Diploma level qualification prior to entry is recommended. Students may be able to gain credits for units completed from the CTI BSB60215 Advanced Diploma of Business where applicable.

Course Pathway:

After graduation from the Advanced Diploma of Leadership and Management other study options include: Diploma of Business, Advanced Diploma of Business, Diploma of Software development, or Diploma of Digital and interactive games at Canterbury Technical Institute. Students also have the option of continuing study at university.
